Artists are invited to submit 3 pieces for \$25, with the option of submitting additional works for \$5 each.

The theme for this event is **“Art in Portraiture.”** (open to subjective or literal interpretation) (Subject of Portrait does not need to be only people)

Formatting Image files for submission:

1. jpgs in standard format, with the longest side at exactly 1200 pixels
2. Jpgs must be labeled: yourlastname_firstname_arttitle.jpg (add a number at the end if you are submitting more than one “Untitled” piece)
3. 3D work may include up to 3 fields to represent each piece – please label clearly. 2D works allowed one file per piece

Acceptance Notification: Email notification no later than midnight February 9th.

Accepted Work Drop-off: Work must be dropped off on Sunday, February 17th 1 - 4 pm.

Work pick-up: Unsold work must be taken home at 10 pm at the end of the Event. If artist is unable to take work at that time, he or she must make arrangements for someone else to take – or store – their work.

Eligibility and Conditions

Original works executed by the artist that have not been displayed previously in a 4th Friday Art Show are eligible. Artist may submit paintings, drawings, sculpture, prints, textiles, photographs, jewelry and mixed media pieces. Installation-style artwork will be considered on an individual basis with the responsibility of the installation resting on the artist within the schedule of the 4th Friday event. No dimension of any work may exceed 8-feet, and work must be able to fit through a 35" x 83" doorway.

Incomplete entries will not be considered. Accepted works must be hand-delivered. No shipments can be received.

Acceptance in the Exhibit is not guaranteed.

Artist Guidelines:

- 2D artwork must be wired to hang (no sawtooth hangers)
- 3D work must be accompanied by instructions and presentation apparatus if available, standard display pedestals are not adequate.
- A label must be affixed to the back of artwork with artist's name and work title.
- 4th Fridays reserves the right to not include any delivered artwork deemed unsuitable. Reasons include, but are not limited to: work not ready to hang, unprofessional presentation, concern for condition of piece, piece significantly different from juried image.
- Substitutions of artwork not allowed.
- All displayed work must be for sale and will be subject to a 20% commission if sold. Checks from our accounting department will be issued within 3 weeks of the sale.
- 4th Fridays will make every reasonable effort to protect your work while it is in our possession, we are not legally responsible for it. Please consider insuring your work.
- Accepted work may be used for publicity.
- Work must remain hanging until 10pm on the night of the Event.
- At 10pm, please take any unsold artwork home through the 400 door check-out.
- If you are unable to take your work at the end of the show, you must make other arrangements in advance.
- Uncollected work becomes the property of Starline Factory 7 days after the Event.

Starline Factory acts as agent for the artists to submit, exhibit and sell artwork. Sales tax is collected and paid on each sale. Artists are responsible for compliance with income tax filing requirements related to the sale of their artwork.
